Publishing your work open access has just got easier

Your institution has an agreement with Wiley which allows researchers to publish open access in hybrid* journals at no cost to yourself

Your work will be available for everyone to read, cite and share

Eligibility

To publish under this agreement, the article's corresponding author must be from a participating institution and the article must have been accepted on or after the start date of the agreement.

Things to Know About Publishing Open Access Through This Agreement

You don't need to find the Article Publication Charge (APC), publishing charges are arranged centrally by your institution.

Gold Open Access | Publishing your article gold open access means:

- The final peer reviewed, publisher version of your article is made freely available online
- Access to your article is immediate and permanent
- Most funder and institutional requirements to make an article open access are satisfied – including authors funded by coalition S.
- You retain copyright, publishing under a Creative Commons license
- Automatic export of the final article to repositories such as PubMed Central (when appropriate)

An article can be gold open access in either a fully gold journal or hybrid journal.

Your institution's agreement with Wiley allows you to publish gold open access in hybrid journals – meaning you have **1,400 journals** to choose from.

Copyright and Licensing

Creative commons license

You retain copyright of your article and publish under a creative commons license.

Where available, you will be offered a choice of Creative Commons licenses (CC-BY, CC-BY-NC, CC-BY-NC-ND) that determine the circumstances under which the article content can be reused.

Licensing

When you publish open access with Wiley, you sign an Open Access Agreement which grants a license to Wiley to publish the article and to identify Wiley as the original publisher.
